

Case Study B.

67- year old male complained that he cannot recover from medium level fever (over 38.4°C) for over two months and was suffering from recurrent migraine for over 6 months. Previously he was having insomnia for about 10 months. Thus he went for a blood check up every two weeks at different hospitals. According to the investigation reports at those hospitals - everything was within “normal“ condition: no infection and no pathologies.

He decided to take antipyretic over 2 tablets per day to relieve his migraine attacks.

Discussions:

After the comprehensive assessment by Ψ -TI diagnostics we discovered a tendency to a brain (pituitary) and pancreatic tumors. He was informed about the situation after dynamic d- Ψ -TC diagnostics tests. He was advised to have from 7 up to 10 Ψ -TC correction sessions until he felt well and would return to normal health condition.

Conclusion:

Ψ -TC correction – 10 sessions in 3 weeks. The patient’s fever went down after two sessions. After 4 sessions, the patient got his long deep sleep and stopped taking antipyretic. After 5 sessions his temperature became normal. After 10 sessions he reported to feel well and as strong as before: no fever, can sleep well and felt satisfied with his health condition.
