

Fever of Unknown Origin (FUO): Dynamic diagnostics for acute cases.

Case Study D

Female aged 49 complained an increasing sharp pain in the nasal cavity, severe headache, shivering, influenza-like syndromes.

Discussions:

The examination by Ψ -TI test has demonstrated the patient having influenza type H1N1 that was rapidly spreading from paranasal area right to the temporal lobe of the cerebral cortex faster than to respiratory system.

Conclusion

Ψ -TI express test demonstrated its efficacy to identify the infection type as well as the dynamics and direction of its activation areas. It allowed us to prevent the sharp reaction, perhaps, caused by cytokine storm and select the proper health program.
