

Depression after accident

Case Study

Female, aged 41, addressed us complaining about depressive and suicidal mood.



History of disease:

Motorcycle accident trauma.
Extensive damage of the soft tissue of the left leg (from knee to thigh)
Could not walk for over 4 months after the surgery.
Developed depression,
Suicidal mood
Insomnia
Former surgery for breast tumor



Discussion:

Ψ -TT assessment revealed no major health defects. Most of her sufferings were perhaps due to stressful situation in her family.

We have advised Ψ -TT correction - 5 sessions during 2 week period as well as cognitive therapy and psychological counseling.

Conclusion and results:

The patient can walk, feels good, relaxed, sleeps well.
