Fever of Unknown Origin (FUO): Dynamic diagnostics for acute cases.

Case Study C

Female, aged 30, complained of headache, myalgia, cough, fast raising temperature over 40°C.

Discussions:

With the purpose to quickly identify the failing systems and organs we have performed the dynamic Ψ -TI test, which was repeated after a period of 10 minutes.

Results:

We observed the rapid decrease of functions in the following organs and systems:

Lung (right) -15 %

Thyroid gland -17%

Blood cells -23 %

The efficiency of Ψ -TI diagnosis helped us to conclude that the Staphylococcus aureus infection was aggressively spreading in the blood system.
